



Hoopla is a free, online resource which Avalon Free Public Library patrons can access using their library card number. Patrons can stream Movies, Music, TV, and Audiobooks on their computer or mobile device.

How to sign up for Hoopla

1. Go to <http://www.hoopladigital.com> in your web browser.
2. In the top right corner, click on the “Sign Up” button.
3. Select “AVALON FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY”.
4. Enter your AVALON LIBRARY CARD NUMBER.
5. Follow the instructions to put in your email and set up your password.

GUIDELINES

- Each patron can check out ten (10) items PER MONTH
- Movies will be automatically returned after three (3) days.
- Music will be automatically returned after seven (7) days.
- Audiobooks will be automatically returned after twenty-one (21) days.
- TV Shows go out by the episode.
- A browser plugin is necessary for desktop access.

Hoopla Digital Supported Devices

iOS (Apple)

hoopla supports any device that supports iOS 6 and newer, including the new iOS 7. This includes the following devices:

iPad 2 and newer, iPad Air, iPad mini,
iPhone 3GS, iPhone 4/4S, iPhone 5/5S, iPhone 6, iPod touch 5th gen. and newer

Android

The Android app is available to any device running 4.0 and newer. If the app is not viewable in the Google Play store on the device, then it is not supported. 10,000+ devices run Android 4.0 and newer but a brief list of popular devices that can run the hoopla app is:

Hoopla can run on Apple TV however there is currently no Roku channel, Xbox channel or Playstation channel. If you have a high-definition television, an HDMI cable and a laptop or tablet with an HDMI port you can plug directly into your television to watch hoopla video through your hoopla Digital supported Internet browser using the necessary plugins as listed below:
