

Have you wondered? You are searching the library catalog and find a book you want, but it's in storage? What does that mean? Can you get it?

The library has an offshore storage facility where additional library materials are kept. They can be requested just like any item in the library itself, and every Friday requested items are picked up and brought to the library.

**Freegal**, the library's music download service, will add a streaming component. Beginning in mid-January, library cardholders will be able to stream music for up to three hours a day with no commercials. Also, every week you can download up to five songs that you then own.
