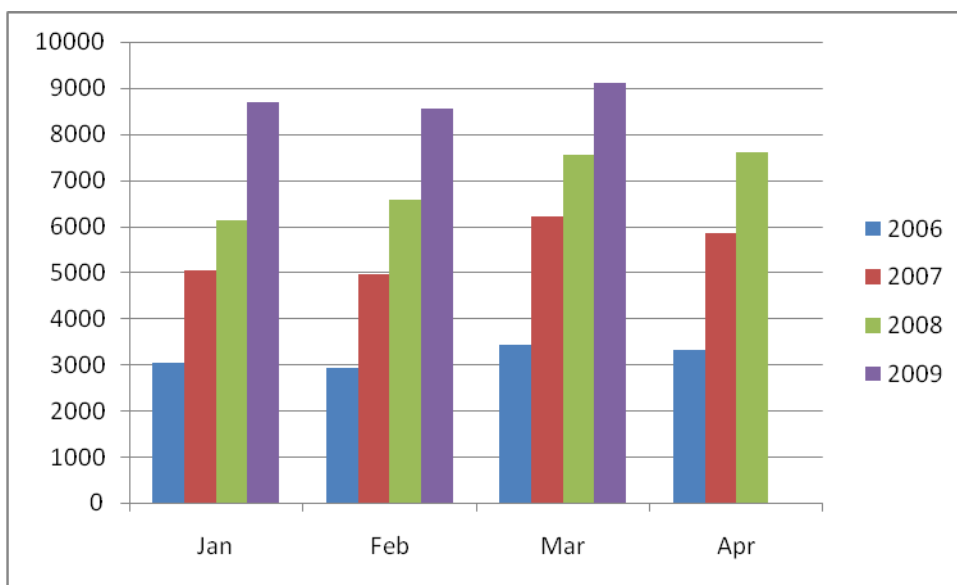


Director's Report for March 2009

March's circulation (9122) increased by 7% over February (8540), and increased 20.9% from this time last year (7547). Year to date figure for 2009 (26364) is 30% above the same period last year (20236).
