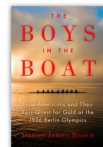

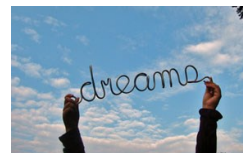
*Felt 3D Animals Workshop with Paige Cunningham
