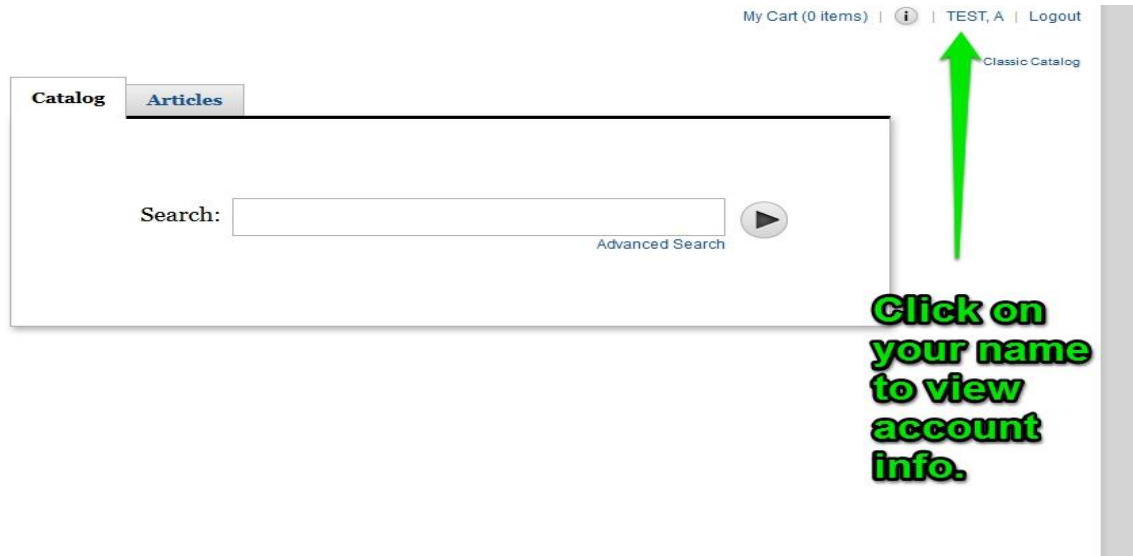

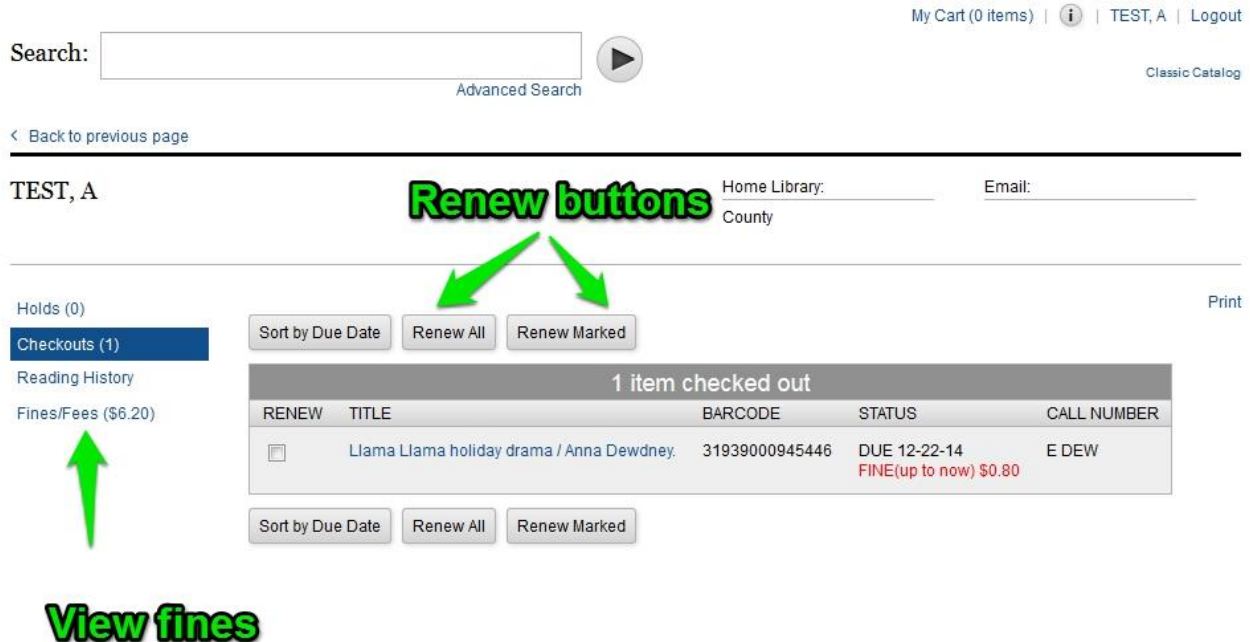

This takes you to the main catalog search screen. To view your account information, click on your name in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.



You can then view the status of your current requests, see your checked-out items, renew any items that are not already overdue or that have not reached their maximum renewal amount of 2 renewals, and view your fines. At this time we do not have the capability for online fine payment but you can pay fines next time you come to the library or you may mail us a personal check for the amount shown. **Reading history:** You can track your reading history in your account, if you prefer, by clicking on the “Reading History” link below “Checkouts” and above “Fines/Fees.” You must select “Opt In” to begin collecting your history; the default patron setting is “Opt Out” until the patron chooses to opt in. The history will only show what you’ve checked out from the time you opted in and will only visible to you. The library does not keep patron reading history in the system.
